### TRIALS FOR THE 2008 ONTARIO WINTER GAMES

The 2008 Ontario Winter Games will be held in Collingwood, Ontario, March 6-9, 2008. These provincial multi-sport competitions for Ontario youth are held every two years and include Air Rifle and Air Pistol.

The Canadian Shooting Sports Association is holding trials to pick the teams to represent the five Ontario regions in the Air Rifle and Air Pistol Competition. The Teams will consist of the top two male and female air pistol shooters each and the top three male and female air rifle shooters each for the five regions. If there are not enough competitors from each region, alternates will be picked from the remaining participants from the trials.
