

# CANADIAN SHOOTING SPORTS ASSOCIATION 2009 OUTDOOR RIFLE CHAMPIONSHIPS

These championships have traditionally held somewhere in the Golden Horseshoe - but from 1998 onward we have occasionally operated them at the new range near Beachburg. It has been quite successful; they have a fine facility there; and the hospitality of the Beachburg Gun Club could not be improved upon. So for 2009 we are going back there for our outdoor Provincial Championships - on July 11 and 12.

The range is about 20 minutes drive from Pembroke and Renfrew, about 4 km south-east of Beachburg on County Road 21 (see map). There are motels in both Renfrew and Pembroke, and primitive camping is available at the range. For camping I suggest you talk to Barry at (613) 582-3857.

We plan to operate the match the same as we did in 2005 (a bit different from the schedule at St. Catharines). The ISSF 3-Position match will be fired Saturday morning, with the ISSF Prone matches on Sunday morning. Sporting and Hunting Rifle will be fired in conjunction with both of these matches; and there will be a Sporting and Hunting Rifle only relay Saturday afternoon.

ISSF Sport Rifle will be for Ladies only, and is fired in conjunction with the ISSF 3-Position Match. Hunting Rifle is a prone match using non-target rifles with a minimum of accessories.

With 40 positions available on Sunday 20 will be reserved for ISSF Prone, 20 for Sporting Rifle. Because of the limited number of positions Sunday we strongly urge any Sporting or Hunting Rifle shooters who can shoot Saturday to do so. Advance reservations are strongly recommended - particularly for Sunday. We will try to

accommodate anyone who shows up as a post entry, but there are no guarantees. And there will be a \$2.00 "Late Entry Fee" for anyone who does not have an advance reservation. Please get your entries in early. We prefer them with fees as it makes for less work at the match but will accept them without fees. But don't try to phone them in Friday night before the match.

**SPORTING RIFLE SHOOTERS NOTE:** we want to group Prone and 3-Position shooters together on the line, so please be sure to specify which relay you wish to use for Prone and which for 3-P: and please stick to it.

**YOUNGER SHOOTERS NOTE:** In line with current SFC rules: a Sporting Rifle JUNIOR is a shooter who has not reached his/her **16th** birthday as of Dec. 31, 2009. An Intermediate Junior (both Sporting and ISSF Rifle) is a shooter who has not reached his/her 21st birthday as of Dec. 31, 2009. **Juniors must indicate date of birth on the entry form.**

Somewhat accidentally we added a Veteran category in the Indoor Provincials; to be consistent we are including it here as well in the Sporting and ISSF Rifle matches. A Veteran is a shooter who has reached his 55<sup>th</sup> birthday as of Dec. 31, 2009.

Please enter early to guarantee yourself a spot and to help us in organizing the match to run smoothly. All advance entries received before June 29 will be acknowledged. Mail your entry to:

## CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE

Registration for ISSF 3-Position will be from 8:30 to 9:00 AM Saturday, July 11. For the other matches registration will be on a continuing basis up to the close of each days shooting and starting at 8:30 each morning.

- Saturday - 8:30 AM: Registration begins  
9:00 AM: ISSF 3-Position, Sport Rifle, & Sporting Rifle Squad #1  
11:00 AM: ISSF 3-Position, Sport Rifle, (Continued) & Sporting Rifle Squad #2  
1:30 PM: Sporting Rifle Squad #3
- Sunday - 9:00 AM: ISSF Prone - Iron Sights, & Sporting Rifle Squad #4  
11:00 AM: ISSF Prone - Any Sights, & Sporting Rifle Squad #5  
2:00 PM: Award Presentations (Time approximate)

Competitors are reminded that they must be on hand ahead of the scheduled starting time to allow for registration and set-up of their equipment - one-half hour is a recommended minimum. The matches will start as scheduled regardless of whether or not all competitors are on hand and vacancies may be filled by post entries.

## EVENTS (All at 50 metres):

- 1: ISSF Free Rifle 3-Position: 40 shots Prone, Standing, and Kneeling (Classified M, EX, SS, MM,VT,IJ)
- 2: ISSF Free Rifle Prone - Iron Sights: 60 shots Prone with Iron Sights (Classified M, EX, SS,MM,VT,IJ,VT)
- 3: ISSF Free Rifle Prone - Any Sights: 60 shots Prone with Any Sights (Classified M, EX, SS, MM,VT, IJ)
- 4: ISSF Sport Rifle: - 20 shots Prone, Standing, and Kneeling (Ladies only - Classified OPEN, JUNIOR)  
(Run concurrently with EVENT #1 using first 20 shots)
- 5: Sporting Rifle Prone: 60 shots (Classified M, EX, SS, MM,VT,IJ,JR)
- 6: Sporting Rifle 3-Position: 20 shots Prone, Standing, and Kneeling (Classified M, EX, SS, MM,VT,IJ, JR)
- 7: Hunting Rifle: 60 Shots Prone (Classified OPEN, IJ)

**AWARDS:** A Provincial Champion plaque (Canadian citizens only eligible) will be awarded to the top shooter in each event. Winners of these awards are ineligible for the classification awards in the corresponding event.

Medals will be awarded in each event in the classes indicated. Seconds will be awarded in all classes with 3 or more competitors; thirds in all classes with 5 or more competitors.

(We reserve the right to combine classes if a match has more than one class with only one or two competitors).

## RULES AND CLASSIFICATIONS:

- 1) SFC Rules and classifications will apply in all matches.
- 2) Shooters without a current SFC classification card will shoot as EXPERTS or MASTERS at CSSA discretion..
- 3) In line with current SFC rules: a Sporting Rifle JUNIOR is a shooter who has not reached his/her **16th** birthday as of Dec. 31, 2009. An Intermediate Junior (both Sporting and ISSF Rifle) is a shooter who has not reached his/her 21st birthday as of Dec. 31, 2009.
- 4) All competitors must be members of the Canadian Shooting Sports Association or the Federation Quebecoise de Tir. Membership in the Shooting Federation of Canada is not mandatory but is strongly recommended: it is required to validate a classification card.
- 5) Either or both the CSSA and SFC may be joined at the match.
- 6) In the ISSF matches time limits will be similar to the Indoor Championships:  
30 minutes for each 20 shots PRONE  
40 minutes for each 20 shots STANDING  
35 minutes for each 20 shots KNEELING
- 7) Sporting Rifle time limits are:  
30 minutes for each 20 shots; Prone, Kneeling, or Standing.

## EQUIPMENT CHECK - SPORTING RIFLE:

- 1) All rifles will be checked before shooting starts for weight (not over 4 kg) and trigger pull (not under 1 kg).
- 2) Rifle dimensions must conform to the SFC rule book. Rifle dimensions will not be checked at weigh-in but we will spot-check any which appear questionable as the match progresses.

## EQUIPMENT CHECK - ISSF EVENTS:

- 1) There will be no specific equipment checks; but as the match proceeds we will spot-check any item which appears questionable. This covers rifles, accessories, and clothing.
- 2) The equipment rules are basically ISSF.

Note that it is the shooter's responsibility to make sure his/her equipment complies with the rules. If a rifle or other equipment fails a spot-check scores already fired may be disqualified. If you are in doubt about any item bring it over to be checked out before the match.

## MATCH ENTRY FEES

ISSF 3-POSITION: 120 shots      \$22.00 for adults, \$14.00 for Juniors\*

ALL OTHER MATCHES:      \$16.00 for adults, \$10.00 for Juniors\*

**PACKAGES:** If more than one match is entered the full fee is charged for the first match only; the fee for each additional match is reduced by \$2.00 for Adults, \$1.00 for Juniors. For example, a package of ISSF Prone (Iron & Any) & ISSF 3-Position would be \$50.00 for Adults or \$32.00 for Juniors.

\*Reduced entry fee for JUNIORS applies only if shooter is competing for JUNIOR awards only.

To be eligible for classification awards a JUNIOR must pay the full entry fee.
